The Government of Sindh, School Education Department is pleased to introduce Non Formal Education Management Information System (NF-EMIS) which is a computer based software solution to work efficiently and effectively to meet the objectives of Literacy & Non-Formal Education.

**A. Features of NF-EMIS**

NF-EMIS is specifically designed for the use by decision makers and administrators to plan and administer Non Formal Education interventions in a more systematic manner. It facilitates in adopting a comprehensive data driven approach in all the following stages of project and program implementation:

- Planning
- Implementation
- Monitoring
- Evaluation

**B. Operationalizing NF-EMIS**

1. District level NF-EMIS cell of the Directorate of Literacy & Non Formal Education shall collect and maintain district level data of Non Formal Education and transmit to Provincial level NF-EMIS.
2. NF-EMIS shall be further consolidated and integrated with Provincial and National EMIS to reflect a holistic picture of Education and literacy in the Province.
3. NF-EMIS shall be utilized to monitor and report the SDGs indicators especially those relating to enrolment, retention, quality/learning achievements and literacy levels of adults.
